1st I will

2^d I will that all my last debts be paid out of my
money that may belong to my estate

3^d I will that all my children had a good english
Education and the expence be paid out of my Estate

4th I will that all my stocks of every description all my
household and kitchen furniture all my plantation implements
and all my crop be sold and the money arising from said sale
be appropriated as above so far as it may be required and
that my negroes be hired out for two years and all of said
money arising from the sale as above and from the hire of
my negroes also after paying all my last debts and all my
expences that may be for schooling my children, &c.
together with a proper valuation of my Negroes be summed
up together and there six hundred and eighty nine dollars
& some five cents be added to that total sum as above which
amount of \$89.75 etc I have let my children have and will
charge them respectively at the latter end of this my will &
that they receive each one named the amount annexed to his
respective name as a part of their as a part of their portion
of my estate in dividing the said the balance of which I
will be divided in the following manner (viz) from one sum
part of the whole total as above deduct ninety two & fifty
cents and the amount of the remaining sum I will and
bequeath unto the lawful heirs of my son Henry H. Burt
but for his use during his life time also from one seventh
part the whole total as above deduct five hundred and
forty dollars - and the remainder I place in the hands
of my son James S. Burt in money to be kept at
lawful interest so long as my daughter Harriet shall
remain the wife of James Bigbee If my daughter Harriet
should live longer than said James Bigbee her Heirs and

Sepe Burt's will continued

After his death I will that she have said money with all its increase to make use of for her support but should James Bigbee her husband live longer after the death of my daughter Harriet I want her to live here if any to have the the aforesaid money and its increase but if my daughter Harriet should die without any living heirs I will that the said money and increase then be equally divided between my other children & I appoint my son James G. Burt trustee for my daughter Harriet to manage as above and upon the death of the said James G. Burt for the Superior Court of this County to appoint another trustee to manage the said money as above from one seventh part of the whole total, deduct fifty dollars & twenty five cents and the remainder I will to the living heirs of my son James G. Burt but to be used for his support during his life and seventh of the whole total as above I will to the living heirs of my son William D. Burt but to be used for his support during his life time. One seventh of the whole total as above I will to the living heirs of my daughter Mary C. Burt but to be used for her support during her life time and the remaining two sevenths of my estate I will to the living heirs of my two little daughters Martha A. Burt & Nancy H. Burt to be kept in one common stock - untill one of them shall either marry or become twenty one years old and for it to be used for their support during the time they may live. I now appoint my son James G. Burt & Hyram Reid my lawful executors to the foregoing will & Testament with discretionary power to sell any part or the whole of my property privately and to hire out the negroes in like manner I witness whereof I the said Sepe Burt have hereunto set my hand and seal this 11th day of August 1826
