make constitute and ordain the following instrument
of writing as my last will and testament in words following
(Ver)

I Item 1st I will that all my just debts be paid with
as little delay as possible out of any money due me
the balance of which to be for the purchase of horses
Mary & Elizabeth
Item 2nd I give to my daughter Ann Hopson sixty
acres of land in appropria for the east line of the lot
whereon I now live that is lot M (220) two hundred
and twenty also two negroes Venus a woman and

Item 3rd I give to my son David B Keaton one hundred and one and one fourth acres of land siting the east half of lot 217 two hundred and one and one fourth acres of land siting the land purchased from Treble Nightingale also two negro boys called Aaron and Paul one bay horse one bed and furniture & one fourth part of field the stock and household and kitchen furniture except the bees

Item 4th I give to my daughter Mary Keaton at the death of my wife Rebecca Keaton one half of the balance of the lot of land wherew I now live after running off the sixty acres as before given to my daughter Ann Hopson also one negro man free and a girl called Sabal one horse saddle and bridle one bed and furniture one fourth of the stock household and kitchen furniture all of which she is to have when she may marry or arrive at lawful age except the land which she is to have at the death of my wife

Item 5th I give to my daughter Elizabeth Keaton at the death of my wife Rebecca Keaton one half of the balance of the lot of land wherew I now live after running off the sixty acres as before given to my daughter Ann Hopson also two negro girls called Hannah & Eliza one horse saddle and bridle one bed and furniture one fourth of the stock household and kitchen furniture all of which (except the land) she is to have when she may marry or arrive at lawful age and the land at the death of my wife

Item 6th I give to my beloved and affectionate wife Rebecca Keaton during her natural life the whole of the balance of the lot of land wherew I now live after running off the sixty acres as before given to my daughter Ann Hopson also two negroes Luke and Daphna one fourth of the household and kitchen furniture one yoke of oxen & cart one bed and furniture (also the pair of stee marey of my daughter Mary and Elizabeth until they marry or arrive at lawful age) two mares one black & one other a flea better good and at the death of my wife the negroes Luke & Daphna and the one fourth of the household and kitchen furniture oxen & cart the two mares as before named are to be sold and the

proceeds thereof to be equally divided between my four children
(viz) Ann, David & Mary and Elizabeth for the use of my family
I do hereby appoint my wife Rebecca Keaton
executrix and Richards Cline executor of this my last
will & testament

desirous to settle my worldly affairs whilst I have
strength and capacity do to as I do make and publish
this my last will and testament and first and principally
I commit my soul into the hands of my Creator who
gives it and my body to the earth to be buried at the
discretion of my executors hereinafter named and as to
such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God
to intrust me I dispose of the same as follows

- 1st - of all my will and desire is all my just debts
to be paid out of my estate
- 2nd - I give unto my son Isaac Moreland one negro man
named March with all other things that I have given him
heretofore to him and his heirs forever
- 3rd - I give unto my son Colson Moreland one negro man
named Sam with all other things that I have given him
heretofore to him and his heirs forever
