If he should die without a brother or heir lawfully. Having inserted the above named note on Ormon Land for the purpose of taking out the plot & grant of said drawn Land, I wish my Executor to collect the same, and pay for the plot & grant of said three square of Land, and to deliver to Daniel Chesnut the plot & grant for the within assigned tract for the use and benefit of his Son Isaac as herein expressed.

Fifthly, I nominate and appoint my friend Theophilus Stebens Executor to this my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I hereunto set my hand & seal this twenty first September A.D. 1822 and A.M. & twenty seven

John Allen's Will

Georgia Putnam County In the name of God Amen, I John Allen a citizen of the County and State aforesaid being sick and weak of body but of a sound & disposing mind and memory do hereby make and ordain and establish this my last Will and Testament. First as it regards my body it is my request that it should be buried after my death in a decent and Christian like manner and as it regards my worldly property which now belongs to me, I do bequeath and dispose of the same in the following manner viz Item the first. It is my Will and desire that my Negro boy Armistea should belong to my daughter Frances Allen and after her death that he should belong to her three Daughters Delpha and Lucy and my Negro Girl Iris I give and bequeath to my daughter Ellen A. Allen but if she should die without an heir it is my Will that the before named Negro Girl Iris should then belong equally between the children of my son Seland Allen and the children of my daughter Frances Allen if the balance of my property after my death should not be sufficient to pay off all my debts then it is my Will and desire that the Negroes named above viz Armistea and Iris should be hired out until a sufficient

is raised from force to discharge all of just debts and then disposed of agreeable to my request above but if my property should be (exclusion of the two Negroes will be more than sufficient to pay all my just debts it is my will and desire that the balance should be equally divided between my daughter Francis Allen and son Leland then the second and lastly. I do hereby nominate and appoint my son Leland Allen my Executor of this my last Will & Testament given under my hand and seal this twenty seventh day of June in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred & twenty seven

Putnam County I John Wynn of the County State of Georgia aforesaid being Mente in Body but bound in mind & memory, do make & ordain this instrument of Writing to be my last Will & Testament, for the distribution and management of my property & effects, as follows (viz)

1st I will after my death & my Body decently buried in a Christian like manner & the Expence thereof paid out of my Estate

2nd I will that all my just debts be paid out of any Money belonging to my estate

3rd I will that all my property, (viz) my land whereon I now live, all my negroes (namely, Andy a man Anthony a man, Bob a boy, George a woman, Eliza a woman, Judy a woman & her child Milly, Ann a woman & her four children, Alley, Rachel, Philip & Rose together with all my household & kitchen furniture, all my crop, Plantations tools & Stocks of every kind together with every thing else that does or may belong to my Estate be kept together, on my plantation in one common Stock so long as my beloved wife Mary may live, & remain single & able for the support of my beloved wife aforesaid & all my children, namely Robert J. Wynn, Greenburg Wynn, John J. Wynn, Martha A. Wynn, William J. Wynn, Mary J. Wynn, & James A. Wynn & also for the Education of my children aforesaid but should my beloved wife Mary
