I will to her One hundred Dollars in Money and all the balance to my Children aforesaid to ~~Wynn~~ in one Common Stock until any one of the Girls shall marry or one of the Boys arrive at the age of twenty one Years, Then when either of the girls shall marry or ~~become~~ ^{marry} at the age of twenty one Years or the Boys become twenty one Year old, they are at Liberty to draw from my Estate a proportionable part of my property aforesaid as his or her distributive share of my said Estate and the balance still kept together in one Common Stock and distributed as above until all my Children shall either marry or become twenty one Year old as above, And I hereby nominate & appoint my friend Thomas Johnston Executor to the foregoing Will & Testament with discretionary power to sell any Superfluous production of my Farm, or any thing else necessary to be sold and apply the proceeds thereof to the best Interests of my Family aforesaid. Harwell being in sound mind and knowing the uncertainty of life & the certainty of death make this my last Will & Testament revoking all others if any by me made, I do will & bequeath unto my affectionate Father Anderson Harwell my Negro Boy (worthy to him and his heirs for ever and that my Girl Harriet by him the said Anderson Harwell as he may think most advantageous and the same applied to the payment of my just debts and that the said A. Harwell have and take charge of all my notes & papers and attend to the payment of debt and all the Estates I may have of any Value whatever & appoint the same Anderson Harwell my only Executor to put this my last Will & Testament in to effect
