

The Last will & Testament of John Turner Decd

Putnam County } I, John Turner of the county & State aforesaid being
of sound mind and memory but knowing that all must
die do in order to dispose of the property with which it is pleased
God to bless me make and declare this my last will & Testament as follows

I give to my nephews Wm & Charles S. Turner sons of my brother
Joseph Five hundred dollars each to be in full of Commission or compensation
for executing this will

I give to the three children of Sister Martha Hunt (to wit Susan
Nabitha & William) two hundred & fifty dollars each out of my estate

I give to John Turner Spillers late of Spunk, in Nantuxet, two
Hundred & fifty dollars out of my estate

I give to my said nephew William Turner, Charles S. Turner
& William Hunt my niece aforesaid Susan Hunt & Nabitha Hunt and
the said John S. Spillers the remainder of my estate in the above proportions

I nominate & appoint my said nephews William & Charles S. Turner
executors of this my last will & Testament hereby revoking all other
wills and Testaments heretofore by me made.
