In the name of God Amen I Jonathan Hearn being in perfect health and of disposing mind & memory do make and ordain this my last will & Testament this sixth day of February Eighteenth Hundred & twenty seven

1st I give and bequeth to my beloved wife Betsey Hearn two (Negroes) (to wit) Leah & Sarah one Sorkel (Maid) Name Tip Two Cows & Calves. One Sow & Piggs, two Feather Beds & good furniture two stands of curtains with plates, mats & boards. One painted Cabinet One Saddle & Bridle, two eating Tables, One Chest & trunks with Locks & keys, 4 Red sitting Chairs, One Looking Glass, 1 Set K. & Forks, One earthen plates, two Large Dishes, Six Tumblers, One Coffee Pot One Tea Pot, One Iron Pot One Oven Lid, 1 Set Cup & Saucer, One tea kettle, One Flax Wheel, One Cotton do. One pair Cotton Cards, One set Smoothing Irons, two Water pails her choice, One Washing Tub, One Side Board, One set Fire dogs, One Large Bible and Mercers Cluster, Cummings Testament, One stool Rack, two pair Pot Hooks, and all the Furniture I may be in possession of at my death, and twelve months provision for her little family, and One Loam.

2nd I give unto my beloved Daughter Sarah Elender Hearn Seven Hundred Dollars Cash, by selling two (Negroes) (to wit) Simon & Nancy and the Balance out of the Remainder of my personal Estate.

3rd I give unto my beloved son Zabab Hearn one (Negro) boy Nambia Ebbin Son of Leah

4th I give unto my beloved son Jacob Hearn One Hundred and twelve an a half Acres of Land lying the upper side of the line that divides the fourth & fifth tenth districts of formerly Baldwin but now Putnam County, and one (Negro) Man named Dennis, and the Balance of my Estate remained in this distribution

5th I give unto my beloved son William Hearn Fifty two and one half Acres of Land lying below the line that divides the fourth & fifth tenth District, formerly Baldwin but now Putnam County, being part of No 275 drawn by Henry Pughs of Warren County, and also appoint him my only and sole Executor of this my last will & Testament Ratifying and Confirming the same, as witness my hand and seal the day and date within written

Shadrack Crouch Will

In the name of God Amen
I Shadrack Crouch, Senor of the County of Putnam and
State of Georgia Being low in Health, but of sound Mind
& Memory, do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament
in Manner of form following (viz):
First of all, I give to my son John Crouch, Ten Dollars in
Cash. It is also my desire that my daughter Lavinia
Jackson, have the sum of Ten Dollars. It is also my desire
that my Daughter Polly Much, have the sum of three dollars.
It is also my desire that, after the above Legacies are
paid, my son George Crouch, shall have the balance
of the Estate of which I may be possessed, or to which I may
be entitled, at my decease.

I nominate and appoint my son George Crouch Executor
of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all
others heretofore by me made.
