

3 The Last will and Testament of Abner Holdridge

Georgia { In the name of God Amen. — I Abner Holdridge of the County of Putnam & State aforesaid being very sick but of sound mind & memory Do make and ordain my Last will and Testament —
Item 1st I leave to my beloved wife Lucy Holdridge a Estate both Real & Personal during her widowhood
Item 2^d I will that in case my wife should marry then the Negroes Stock of all kind household & kitchen furniture to be equally divided between my wife & her six children to wit: — Abner Holdridge Thomas (Journey) William George Martha Emily & Caroline & all others that my wife may have by me
3^d I will that all my land be equally divided between six children above named & all that my wife may hereafter have by me
4th I will that my wife be paid by my executors the sum of one hundred dollars to be raised out of my crop in lieu of her part of Land
5th I will that my executors give to my children above named, the one fourth part of all my personal estate as they become of age & may be

I hereby constitute & appoint my wife Lucy Holdridge John A. & Thomas Holdridge my Executors of this my Last will & Testament & hereby revoke all other Testaments or wills made by me here by ratify & confirming this and no other to be my Last will and Testament
