Micajah White's will

In the name of God Amen
I Nicopolis White of the State of Georgia and County of
Putnam being Mank of body but sound of mind and memory
do make this my last will and testament, dated June 24th
of the year of our Lord one thousand Eight Hundred thirty five
and forty ninth year of American Independence

1. I wish that my Just debts be paid first,
2. I wish that my loved wife keep the land plantation, and the land I drew in 18th May 1826 and plantation tools House hold and kitchen furniture, Horses, Cattle, Hogs, Sheep and poultry also the Engraves namely Harry Pies Liza Polly Sally Fanny Harriet Mary Florida Charity and Easter and all debts due me and property or money becoming or belonging to me by friendship or otherwise to be kept together for the maintenance of my wife and children and to give my children their Education

3 I will that my Executors have full power to sell and convey my land or any part thereof or Negro or Negroes or any other part of my property, that they and my beloved wife may think for the benefit of my beloved wife's children and to purchase land or Negroes or other property as the interest of my heirs may require, and take titles to or make them and the same to be valued in law as though I made or received them in my lifetime.

Micajah White Will

- Item 4 I Will that my Eldest Son Jeph-eh White shall when he arrives at
lawful age have a good Horse Saddle and bridle and a good suit of
clothes and ten young cows and two sows pigs one horse and
Guano, two Ewes and four good Hens five dollars the same to
be done for John B White and James M White, as they shall arrive
at lawful age
- Item 5 I Will that my daughter Elizabeth P Allen have the bay filly
and a good saddle & bridle bridle what she has already received
Twenty five dollars in Port Bacon corn half one Bushel an in an
Guano two cows two sows and pigs two Ewes and four good
and my daughter Mary White is to have the same in every part
- and except the filly in place of which she is to have a Horse
worth twenty four dollars
- Item 6 I Will that when my beloved wife shall die or if she
remains a widow till the youngest child arrives at age at
either time all my Estate then remaining shall be sold or
divided by lot according to law equally between my beloved
wife and all my Children
- Item 7 I Will that all my property be appraised as soon as conven-
ient after my decease and in case my Executors and my beloved
wife should not agree in any case that the Choise five free
holders to determine the same
- Item 8 I Will that James Jackson William H Pearson and
Judah White be my Executors and Executive to carry the
my last will and testament into Execution hereby requesting
said James miles as mying my Hand Seal this 24th
June 1825
