Now the name of the Lord Amen I Green Bailey of the State of Georgia Putnam County do make and ordain this my last will and testament in the manner and form following viz I give to my three eldest children Thomas Green and Susan M. tracts of land lying on in the sixth district of Appling the other in the sixth district of Crum the remaining part of my estate I leave with my beloved wife and four youngest children William Moray Nancy and David to be kept together for the use of the same during my wife's life then to be sold and equally divided among the above mentioned four children To which will I have my wife and sons Thomas and William Executors the same executors to have power to sell the land when they shall think proper In witness whereof I set my hand and seal, done in presence of us this 1st day of Dec. 1822.

I Nancy Lunsford of the state of Georgia Putnam County being in my perfect senses and knowing that it is appointed for man once to die do make this my last will and testament that is to say I wish all my just debts to be paid first then all just charges and expenses to be paid and all the rest of my goods and chattels I give and bequeath to my Father Moses Lunsford for the use of his children ratifying and confirming that and no other to be my last will and testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty
