Item 1st I give & bequeath unto my two grand Children William St. McLeary, and Pamela Patience of the County the following Negroes: to wit Paddy & her two Children Viny & Abigail Spanish Maria Little Comfort Little Buck and their Increase Item 2nd It is my will and desire that the above named negroes and their Increase shall be kept to & given unto William St. McLeary at the age of twenty five Years or Pamela Patience and then an equal Division to be placed between them for Paddy and her Children and future Increase to be put into Pamela St. McLeary

Valuation. I leave William & or Pamela P. McLeary du before they get possession of the above Legacy. It is my desire - will that the first of parts be equally divided between the surviving Children of James of James McLeary by his first wife Catharine, Item 3rd I give the worth of my grandsons Thomas E and Michael W. McLeary two hundred dollars each I give to my grand son William W. and my grand daughter Pamela P. McLeary two hundred dollars each and to William W. & Pamela P. one bed each and each bed to be furnished with the best furniture that I have I also give to Pamela P. one New Worsted Counterpane & Dear dear Item 4th I give to my Daughter Martha Curran my Mahogany Secretary. Item 5th I give to my Daughter Mary Ellison my Mahogany Folding Table & Chair & Table. Item 6th I give to my grand daughter Martha Ann Matilda Ellison two hundred dollars. Item 7th It is my will and desire that all the property that I have, which I have not specifically disposed of be sold and the above Money Legacies, paid off and the remainder of any be equally divided between my surviving Children and their issue in default. My Sons John & Zachariah Edwardson & John Curran. My Executors May 23rd 1826. Signed in the presence of Zachariah Edwardson and Margaret Halladay.

Lee of the Putnam County aforesaid being in a low state of health - but of perfect and sound Memory, sound and Injunctive do make and declare this instrument of Writing for and as my Last Will and Testament of and Concerning and bequeathing all such property as I may be possessed of both Claim or may be entitled unto in any manner or way, whether at the time of my decease Item 1st I will & hereby order and direct that all my Just Debts be paid and as soon as it may be in the power of my Executors Item 2nd It is my Will that my Executors at this discretion do sell or much of my property as will pay off all demands or just debts against me Item 3rd It is my desire that my beloved wife Elizabeth & her heirs do have all my property that is left after paying
