sold to pay my debts & Burial expences. Hoping
that my sister Peggy & Nephew Franklin C. Sanford
will have nothing lacking that may pertain to a
decent burial
4th I wish my sister Peggy to have my Bed cloath
and all other ~~clothing~~ property that is mine that is not
herein mentioned equally divided amongst my Mother
Grand Children
5th I give to my Nephew Robin Patrick my part
of a tract of land in Watton County said tract of
Land drawn by my mother. Lastly my wish is
that I be buried by my Father & Mother at Greensborough
6th I do appoint my sister Peggy Curry & Franklin
Curry Sanford my true and lawful Executor and
Executor this my last wishes interchangeably made
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this ~~Twenty~~ day of August In
the Year of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred &
