Georgia } In the name of God Amen
Putnam County } I Robert Ashurst of this State and county now
suffering under bodily affliction but of sound mind and memory for
which I give good thanks for the same and calling to mind the
shortness of my body and knowing that all that born must die do
make and ordain this my last will and testament principal and first
of all I give and recommend my soul to the hands of God who gave
it my body I recommend to His ordained priest hands as for the
worldly goods that it has pleased God to bless me in this life, it is my
will and desire to dispose of in the following manner and form
following— It is my will that my mules on murder Creek and
the lands that I purchased of with them be sold for the benefit of my
Estate in a parcel from one to four years one fourth of the purchase
money paid annually— the balance of my land to be held in
reserve for the use and behoof of my wife and children until my youngest
child becomes of age or marries after that time to be equally divided
between my surviving Legates in such manner and form as they think
most convenient to the benefit of a majority of my said Legates
It is further my will and desire that all my negroes with my
stock of all kinds together with my household and kitchen furniture
be kept together as one common stock for the benefit of my wife and
children to be given off to each Legate in the manner and form
following (to wit) Was each Legate become of law full age or married
then the other or they share receive that proportionable part of my Estate in such
manner and form as my Executors think most beneficial to the interest
of my Estate not exceeding a Legate's part at that time and each
Legate's part to be of the same as the first in proportion and as after
each Legate has his share there be a day's sleep left to be again

divided amongst my above named Legacies Equally It is my will that my Executors shall divide parts of my property as they think not advantageous to be kept together, I hereby nominate and appoint my dearly beloved wife Martha Ashurst John Alland and Matthew Stacey to be Executors to this my last will and testament and Reserving all other heretofore made or said to be made by me In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this twelfth first day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred thirty five

 aforesaid being old and infirm in body but of sound mind
 and memory do make and devise this my last will
 and testament as follows to wit I hereby bequeath
 my beloved Son Francis Wearn his heirs and assigns forever
 my ^{try} James and also my negro man named Henry to my
 beloved Son Eliza Wearn and after his death the said Henry
 and his increase to be equally divided between my beloved
 Son Francis Wearn & John Wearn and their heirs and
 assigns forever
 I thus my will and devise is that my Executors do make
 payment to the Estate of Eliza Wearn her and the amount
 of five hundred thirty one dollars and of the surplus make
 an Equal division between their day to time and their heirs
 and assigns forever
 Lastly I appoint my Son Francis Wearn & John
 Wearn my Executors to carry into full effect the contents
