State of Georgia Being low in Health, but of sound Mind
& Memory, do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament
in Manner of form following (viz)
First of all. I give to my son John Crouch. Ten Dollars in
Cash. It is also my desire that my daughter Lavinia
Jackson. have the sum of Ten Dollars. It is also my desire
that my Daughter Polly Welch, have the sum of three dollars
It is also my desire that, after the above Legacies are
paid, my son George Crouch. Shall have the balance
of the Estate of which I may be possessed, or to which I may
be entitled, at my decease
I nominate and appoint my son George Crouch Executor
of this my last Will and Testament. hereby revoking all
others heretofore by me made
In testimony of all which I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this 2nd day of October Eighteen Hundred
Twenty One
