riage I Give the Whole of my Estate of every descrip-
tion to my dear beloved Son Henry Rees Stembrage and Gibney
Temple to them and their heirs forever to be Equally Divided
between them. Except two hundred dollars which I
Give to my said Son Henry Rees Stembrage to be paid
him out of my Estate before any division.

it is my particular Request that my dear beloved
wife Betsey Stembrage & particular friend William
Hudson being Executors and Executors to this my last
will & Testament in witness I have hereunto
set my hand & seal this 12 day of May 1822

3rd It is further my will & desire that my wife should
have the Soving & schooling of all my children that's
now with her

4th I will & bequeath unto my Sons viz Alexander
Seth Stephen Bowling, Thomas Jefferson, & James New
ton one Lot of Land containing Two Hundred and
Sixty acres Lying in the County of Early in the fourth
District and fourth number to be Equally divided
Share & Share alike

5th I appoint my wife Susan Williams and
Louis Daniel my Executors to this my last will &
testimony to act and do for me as they would have
others do for them when they are numbered among the
dead in Testimony whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and Seal my Seal this twelfth day of
April A.D. 1822
