In the Name of God Amen I Jones Wynn of Putnam County Being fully affected both in My Common Mind, Knowing My Mind fully, that it is appointed time for all men to die I make this My last Will and Testament First I give My Soul to God the Author of My Existence and My body to the Dust From Whence it Came to be Entombed at the Discretion of My Executors and as to My worldly Goods I wish them Disposed of in the following Manner First I give & bequeath unto my faithful Wife Hannah Wynn all My goods & Chattels Land & Tenements during her life time or Widowhood only as my lawful Legatee Comes of age I give unto them each one Hundred Dollars And after her Death or Widowhood then the above Estate to be Equally Divided among all my Legatee. Then I do make & ordain My Wife Hannah Wynn & George Wynn My Sole Executors to this My last Will and Testament In Witness Whereof I have hereunto Set My hand & Seal & affixed My Seal this fifteenth day of Oct. 1824 Eliza Chas. & I declared in presence of us and the in the presence of each other
