Sufficiently educated to make a good English scholar and my three youngest daughters should be taught to read and write tolerably well.

Item 15th I after the death of my wife and after my youngest child becoms of age and after the division before mentioned there should be any property or effects of any description or money in hand left I hereby give the same to my said three sons John, Henry and Eli to be equally divided among them.

Item the 16th I give unto my dying advice, as it were left in the hands of my executors in writing, without duty it shall be to give to each one a true copy of the original.

Item the 17th should it be really necessary at any time in the judgement of the Inferior Court that my children should have a Guardian it is my wish that William H. Slaughter should ~~have~~ ^{incure} that appointment.

Item 18th I do hereby nominate and appoint William H. Slaughter and John M. Minter my executors to execute and carry into effect what my last will and testament hereby revoking all other wills or bequests made by me in testimony whereof I the said British Court have hereunto set my hand by making my mark and affixed my seal this 22nd day of July in the year 1826

This Instrument witnessed that I Emelia Fries of the State of Georgia & Putnam County being of sound mind & memory do make, ordain & publish this my last will & testament. It is my will and desire and I do accordingly bequeath all my property except my bed & furniture consisting of two negro women Phillis & Lark my horse and stock and all my interest in the estate of Daniel Fries dead, whatever it may be to be divided equally ^{between} my sister Emelia's children and the children of my sister Olanck Peters Mrs. Nathaniel Peters however to keep the possession of the same and to use the same until the youngest child comes off age when said property is to be divided one half to Emelia's children and the other half to Diana's children.

It is my will & desire that my bed & furniture be given to the two daughters of Amelia and I do hereby appoint Nathaniel Peters my true and lawful executor. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 22nd day of February 1827.

her choice, five head of sheep one dozen hogs such as she chooses turkeys
and furniture the rest of the household furniture the taken furniture and
plantation tools I want my wife I am to have whatever she and my
son Archibald thinks she needs all of which property at the death of my
wife is to return to my heirs except the negro woman Betty.
2nd I give & bequeath unto my son Samuel two negroes Amy & Lett
by his paying unto the rest of my heirs one hundred and fifty dollars.
3rd I give and bequeath unto my daughter the girl M. Kate a
negro girl by the name of Dinah which negro girl is to
return back to the rest of my children if Abigail dies without
any issue my daughter Abigail is to have three hundred dollars
less than my other children which is the worth of the negro girl
Dinah out of my other property.

4th It is my wish and desire that the rest of my property not
heretofore named should be equally divided among my heirs i.e.
Archibald, Samuel, Abigail, Nancy, Mary and my grandson
Green Turner if any of the above named heirs die without issue
their part is to return back to be divided among the rest of
my heirs. 5th I want my land and all the rest of my property not
heretofore named to be sold by my executors in order to make the
division heretofore named. Lastly I do hereby nominate and
appoint my son Archibald my executor to this my last will and
testament. I also wish my son Archibald also to have the control
of my Grandsons part Green Turner to sell or to clothe or any
