 that my beloved wife does not want
 after my death can be sold that
 my wife does not want to keep I do
 make and constitute my beloved
 Brother James C. Landa my Executor
 to carry out my last will and

 her death then my Executor James C

 I C Landa can keep at 1000 Dollars
 If the said chooses so to do
 I bequeath and give I C Landa my
 Executor one hundred Dollars also I
 give and bequeath to Wm C Philpau
 one hundred Dollars and my
 Backs I bequeath and give to Joseph
 Wood all one hundred Dollars

Also I bequeath and give to Morgan
 Woodall fifty Dollars, also I give and
 bequeath to Sam Coffee one hundred
 Dollars. If there is that much to spare
 after we are both dead and not otherwise.
 After we are both dead I wish my executor
 I demand to give to young Baptist
 preaching one hundred Dollars apiece
 as long as my estate shall last and he
 shall be the Judge of this and wish my
 executor to carry out my last will
 and Testament and I wish my executor
 to be well paid for all his trouble over
 and above all the rest I Baby and
 Eliza Dore has lived together in the County
 of Low 51 years and Eliza Dore has lived
 in the Baptist Church 36 years and I
 wish us both to be decently buried in a
 Christian like manner and I wish
 I demand to preach, both our funeral
 sermons I hereby appoint Jas C Darnod
 to be my lawful executor and to pay all
 my ^{just} debts and to carry out this my last
 will and Testament
 I Baby Dore do publish this to be my
 last will and Testament revoking
 all others that has been made hitherto
