desire that all my Just Debts be paid
soudly - I give and bequeath and
direct to my beloved wife
Jane all of my property both
real and personal consisting of
my land Horses Cattle and hogs
and shop and all other property
and effects belonging to me during
the time she remain a widow
then provided she marries again
to be equally divided among my children
and my wife Jane, also when my
children be come of age for her to give
them such an amount so she
may think she can conveniently do
and spare I also bequeath the
residue of my property
both real and personal
to my wife Jane for and
during her natural life provided
she remain a widow
