said deceased which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge
of the said James Stubbs Administrator, or into the hands or possession
of any other person or persons for him and the same so made do exhibit into
the said Court of Ordinary when he shall be thereunto Required and such
Goods Chattels and Credits do well and truly administer according to Law
and do make a Just and true account of all his actings and doings thereon when
Required by the Superior Court or Register of Probates for the County and
all the Rest of the Goods Chattels and Credits which shall be found
remaining upon the account of the said administration the same being
