of the Balance with the Rest of my Children — Fourth I
in the Event of the Death or Marriage of my Wife Elizabeth
Wilborn that the whole of my property in the case of her
Death be Equally divided between all my Children living
to the above named Mary Jane and Elizabeth Ann the same
two hundred and fifty dollars each over and above an Equal
Share with the Balance of my Children and in case of her
Marriage the whole of my Estate besides the third part which
I leave my Wife (during her lifetime to be Equally divided
between all my children leaving the above amount set apart

part of my Estate which I leave my Wife at her death

will that my Wife shall be at Liberty to sell any Surplus stock
