Scaled with our Seals and dated this Eighth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty six.

The Conditions of the above Obligation is such that if the above Isaac Carter Administrator of the Goods chattels and credits of James Carter late of this County deceased, do make a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods chattels and credits of the said deceased which have or shall come to the hands, possession or knowledge of the Isaac A. Carter or into the hands or possession of any other person in trust for him; and the same so made, do exhibit into the said Court of Ordinary who he shall be thereto required; and such Goods, chattels and credits as well and truly administer according to Law, and do make a just and true account of his actings and doings thereon, when required by the Superior Court or Register of Probates for the County, And all the rest of the Goods, chattels and credits, which shall be found remaining upon account of the said administration, the same being first allowed by the said Court, Shall deliver and pay to such persons respectively, as are entitled to the same by Law, and if it shall hereafter appear, that any last will and testament was made by the said deceased, and the same be known before the Court, and the Executors obtain a certificate of the probate thereof, and the said Isaac A. Carter do in such case, if required render and deliver up the said letters of administration, then this obligation to be void. Else remain in full force.
