firmly by these presents. Sealed with our Seals and dated this sixth
day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and
thirty seven — The Condition of the above obligation is such
that if the above bound, Lucinda, Salisbury, administratrix of the
Goods, Chattels and credits of James G. Salisbury, late of this County
deceased, do make a true and perfect inventory of all and singular
the goods, Chattels and credits of the said deceased, which have or
shall come to the hands, possession or knowledge of the said Lucinda
Salisbury, or in to the hands or possession of any other person or persons
for her, and the same so made, do Exhibit into the said Court of
Ordinary, when she shall be thereunto Required; and such Goods,
Chattels and credits, do well and truly administer according to Law,
and do make a Just and true account of all her, actings and doings
thereon, when Required by the Superior Court or Register of
Probates for the County; And all the rest of the goods, Chattels
and credits, which shall be found remaining upon the account of
the said administration, the same being first allowed by the said
Court, shall deliver and pay to such persons respectively, as are entitled
to the same by Law, and if it shall hereafter appear, that any Last
Will and testament was made by the said deceased, and the same be
proved before the Court, and the Executors obtain a Certificate of the
Probate thereof, and the said Lucinda, Salisbury, do in such case,
if required, Render and deliver up the said Letters of administration.
