sum, jointly and severally, and firmly by these presents, sealed with our
seals, and dated this this first day of January 1838

The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound
Moses Alexander, Administrator of the Estate Real and personal of
John, I. Alexander late of this county deceased, do make a true and
faithful Inventory of all the Estate, Both Real and personal, of Said
deceased, which have or shall come into the hands, possession or knowledge
of the said, Moses Alexander, or into the hands or possession of any other
person or persons for him, and the same so made do exhibit into the said Court
of Ordinary when he shall be ^{thereunto} required and such Estate do well and truly
administer according to Law, and do make a just and true account of all actions
and damages therein when he shall be thereunto required by the Court of Ordinary
for said County, and all the Rest of the said Estates which shall be found,
remaining upon the amount of the said administration, the same being first allowed
by the Court shall deliver and pay to such person or persons respectively as are
entitled to the same, by Law. And if it shall hereafter appear that any
last will and testament was made by the deceased and the same be proven
before the Court of Ordinary, and the Executor obtain a certificate of the probate
thereof, and the said Moses Alexander, do in such case if required render
and deliver up the said Letter of administration, then this obligation to
