 shall take charge of all my temporal Affairs and make such sales
 of property either private or Publick as he and his Mother may think
 best for the Family and Creditors so as not to make unnecessary sacrifices
 and after all just debts are paid I want what may be left to
 remain under the control of the said A. B. Tucker & his Mother
 for the use of herself & Children the Girls while they remain single
 and the Boys until they are of age and at the death of his Mother
 for the property to be divided or disposed of as any Judge or Court
 shall say will make the Children nearest Equal And as the words
 here written fully Express my Will & Wishes I hope it will
 never be considered ~~an~~ unlawful for want of form &c
