The Condition of the above Obligation is Such that if the above bound William Dunn Administrator of the Estate Real & personal of William Camp Late of this County Shall as Make a true & faithful Inventory of all the Estate Real & personal of said Decedent which have or shall come into the hands possession or Knowledge of the said William or into the Hands or possession of any other person or persons for him and the same so Made do Exhibit into the said Court of Ordinary when he shall be thereunto required and such do as well & truly administer according to Law and do Make a true and true account of all his actings & doings therein when he shall be thereunto required by the Court of Ordinary for said County and all the rest of the said Estates which shall be found remaining upon the account of the said administrator the same being first allowed by the Court shall deliver and pay to such person or persons respectively as are entitled to the same by Law And if it shall hereafter appear that any Last Will & Testament was Made by the Decedent and the same be proved before the Court of Ordinary and the Executor obtain a Certificate of the probate thereof and the said William Dunn do in such of Required render & deliver up the said Letters of Administration then this Obligation to be Void Else to Remain in full Force Signed sealed and acknowledged in Open Court this day & date
