

Georgia—Richmond county.

In the Superior Court—June Term, 1817.

Present, the hon. Robert R. Reid, Judge.

ON the petition of Llewellen Evans and Mary his wife, stating that a bond was executed by John Carter, for titles to lots of land in Harrisburg, in the penal sum, of two thousand dollars, in which the petitioners were interested, a copy whereof as near as the petitioner could recollect was annexed to the said petition, and is now lodged in the clerk's office, together with an affidavit pursuant to the act of the general assembly in such cases made and provided, and praying the benefit of the said act, and other circumstantial proof being laid before the court—It is ordered that the said Bond be established as directed by the said act, on the said Llewellen and Mary Evans publishing a notice as therein required, and for the space of six months, in one of the public gazettes of the state, unless cause be shewn to the contrary within the said six months or other matters be shewn to the court against the same.
