} RULE NISI.

UPON the petition of James Gardner, praying the foreclosure of the equity of redemption of, and in a certain LOT of LAND, lying and being in the city of Augusta, fronting on Broad & El is streets thirty-three feet, being part of lot number thirty-four in said city, which had been mortgaged by the said James Murren in his life time to the said James Gardner to secure the payment of Fifteen hundred dollars, and on motion of Richard Henry Wilde, attorney for the petitioner,

It is ordered, That the Heirs or Representatives of the said James Murren, the mortgager, do pay into court, within twelve months from the date hereof, the principal, interest and costs due upon the said mortgage, or the equity of redemption, will be from thenceforth bared and foreclosed, and other proceedings take place, in conformity to the directions of the act in such case made and provided.

And it is further ordered, That a copy of this Rule be served upon the Heirs or Representatives of the said James Murren, six months before the time appointed for paying the money, or published in some public Gazette of this state, once a month for twelve months previous to the time of payment as above.
