

I Abiel Campfield do make and declare

as my last will and testament

First It is my will and desire that all my just debts be
paying to the order prescribed by law for the payment of Debts
real and personal estates; it is also my wish that my estate
be so managed as to save out of it something toward the support
of my wife and children, and believing that this cannot be done
without vesting my executors with extraordinary powers, I do hereby
give my whole estate both real and personal to my executor herein
after named to hold the same and the proceeds and increase thereof
in trust for the uses and purposes herein mentioned, and I do empower
and authorize my said executor and trustees to receive, or sell and
dispose of all or any part of my estate upon such terms and conditions
and at such times and places as they may think most conducive to
the purposes of their appointment, or to lease, hire, plant or improve
the same or any part thereof, and to repair build remove or destroy
houses for the purposes aforesaid and to execute all instruments which
may be necessary to the full execution of said powers

Secondly, If after the payment of my Debts there should be any
property left it is my will and desire that my executor and trustee
hold the same in trust for the use and support of my wife Rebecca
Campfield and her children Hannah, William, Elizabeth, Mary, Peter,
John, Lydia, Octavia and Sarah until the youngest Child come of
age, when it is my wish that it be equally divided between them or
the survivors - Should any of them die before that time their estate
is not to be a vested interest but it is to go to the survivors

I leave it discretionary with my executor and trustees, if after
my children marry before a division takes place, whether such estate
shall afterwards be supported out of my estate in common with the
rest; but should my wife marry before the division takes place
her power over my estate and all her interest in and to the same
is immediately to cease

Thirdly, The powers herein given to my executor and trustees
to be exercised by such as may qualify and the consent of the
major part be necessary to authenticate the acts of my qualified
executor or executors

Fourthly, It is my ardent desire that my wife and children
(and my daughter) and my two sisters Eliza and Sarah should live
in peace and I sincerely hope that they will by reciprocal friendship
and affection as much as possible to happiness of each other
which is near to my heart, is purely recommended

I do hereby certify that the foregoing is a true and correct copy of the
