I ~~do hereby~~ of the State and County aforesaid being of sound mind and memory make and Ordain this to be my last will and Testament, in words and terms following to wit:

I desire that all my last debts shall be first paid and in full that this may be effected as speedily as possible after my death I desire that my Executors hereafter named have full power to sell at public or private Sale with or without any order of Court for any purpose any part of my Estate real or personal desiring that the Executors the same Court over it that I could do if I were living. I desire of me and bequeath to my children John & Rhodes Elizabeth & Gay Aaron Rhodes Nancy B Doyle, Mary Lavinia & Caroline Rhodes all the property of which I might be possessed or be entitled unto after the payment of my debts as aforesaid, Share and Share alike, to them and their heirs. It being my mind and Whereas I have heretofore bequeathed to my Son John & Rhodes property to the amount of Six hundred Dollars, to my Daughter, Elizabeth property to the amount of Six hundred Dollars, to my Son Aaron Rhodes property to the amount of One hundred Dollars & to my Daughter Nancy B Doyle property to the amount of Sixty Dollars,

Now in Order to render the Division of my Estate as equal as possible between all my children it is my will that the said Several Sums above stated be considered a part of the Share or Divisions of each of my said children mentioned as having received them.

I hereby Nominally constitute and Appoint John P. King, John W. Mann, John & Rhodes (my Son) and Richard B. Gay Executors of this my last will & Testament hereby recollecting all better wills heretofore made by me.
