I Relinquish with cheerfulness my Spirit to God who of me
Request that my body be buried by the Side of my dear
that as we were united in life we may not be parted
but may Rest together until the General Resurrection when
Soul and bodies being Reunited we shall meet
likewise of our Garrison to which even I look with
Confidence

As to such worldly goods as I am blessed
I dispose of them as follows

First I Advise that any Abt I may see and my
Confidence be given by my executor without
and that for this purpose as well as for other purposes
I expect my executor to proceed to collect what
may be due to me and to Sell my personal
and that they invest the proceeds of the Sale of my
property, the money I may have on hand at
my death and the money arising from the Sale of
the same that may remain after paying my
debts and expenses and of the proceeds of the
Sale of my real estate of the State of Georgia
in Bond that as my executor shall
My executor shall receive and hold the same in
trust for the purposes aforesaid

the fund indicated in the preceding clause, before the investment
shall be made as therein directed.

Finally

Share alike, and in the further Trust in the event of the death
of my said Daughter without leaving children or issue of children
living at the time of her death or in the event of the death
of such children or issue of children before attaining
age of Twenty one year for the use of my Sons Benjamin
Mannish August and Et Eugene to be equally divided
between them Share and Share alike to them and their
issue but it is my intention that if either of my Sons be then
leaving issue such issue shall represent their Parents

Finally

I give and bequeath unto my executor All the rest
and Residue of my estate of what nature soever it may
consist and wheresoever it may be included especially the
mentioned in the last clause of this will the investment of
which is therein particularly directed in trust for the
Sole and Separate use of my Daughter during her natural life
and after her death in trust for the use of such
children or persons as she shall by will or writing in nature of
appointment and in the absence of such appointments in the
Trust for the use of the children of my said Daughter
living at the time of her death Share and Share alike
and Should any of her children be then dead leaving
issue then such issue shall represent their Parents

will keep the control of her present or any future property
or Liability to his Debt or Contract during her natural
life in the Jointure Trust to and for the use of the children
of my said Daughter, Should she die leaving children
or the issue of children living at the time of her death
to the said children and the issue of children share and
share alike, and in the Jointure Trust in the event of the
death of my said Daughter without leaving children or issue of children
living at the time of her death or in the event of the death
of such children or issue of children before attaining

Fourthly I give and bequeath unto my executors all the real
and Residue of my estate of what nature soever it may
consist and wheresoever it may be including especially the property
mentioned in the first clause of this will the investment of
which is therein particularly directed in trust for the sole
and separate use of my said daughter during her natural life
and after her death in trust for the use of such person
or persons as she shall by will or writing in nature of will
appoint and in the default of such appointments in the Jointure
Trust for the use of the children of my said Daughter
living at the time of her death share and share alike
and should any of her children be then dead leaving
issue then living, such issue to represent their deceased
Parents and in the event of the death of my said
Daughter without leaving issue living at the time of her death
or the issue dying before the age of Twenty one Year
In the Jointure Trust to and for the use of my said
Sons Benjamin, Mansell, August, and Eugene, and
their heirs share and share alike, and it is my
express intention, that should any of my said Sons be
dead on the happening of the event by which they
have bequeathed worldly goods to their heirs.
