After beaver shall have been made to comply with the provisions of the 14th clause of my said will as therein specified. I will and desire that Samuel Holman receive of the earnings of beaver thirty dollars instead of forty as mentioned in the 7th clause of my said will, and that he pay to the executor in said clause specified the sum of twenty dollars per annum for the space of eight years from the time of my death & no longer. And this term is also included of the time he may have to be lived out under the remainder clause of my said will.

10. I will & bequeath to my friend Edward Butler my negro boy Sam, slave
son of Nancy, about two years old, on sacred trust & confidence that he will
grant him his kind protection, & prevent him from being separated from his
mother without the consent, & will make him as free as the laws of this State
will permit.

This clause is explanatory of the 4th clause of my will & the 5th of the bequest. It is to be understood by these clauses that Mr James Coleman is to receive from Warsaw thirty dollars annually for himself besides twenty dollars contributed to the Methodist church & to pay out the said twenty dollars as provided in the clause referred to & for the length of James Thomsen's life. All of which is my true & legal published & declared will.
