my last Will and Testament, that is to say,
that my Will and desire to be decently buried at the discretion
of my Executors.

I Give my Will that all my just debts, and then the money
therein paid out of the funds herein after mentioned.

I Give devise and bequeath unto my Stephen James White, Son
of said White, all my property real and personal lying and being
in the State of Maryland, and whether coming to me or to my
Estate by law equity or otherwise in that State, To hold the same
unto him and assigns forever, I make this devise from a con-
sideration of my property there which is coming to me under my further
provision.

I Give and bequeath unto Mrs. Mary Townsend, Widow, the
sum of One hundred Dollars, and to Elizabeth Townsend her daughter, the
sum of One hundred Dollars, and to Ann Thomas, One hundred Dollars, and
to Mary Thomas, One hundred Dollars, and severally to be paid

of my Executors, and to be by them
in the manner and manner
I do hereby devise and bequeath unto my beloved wife
my estate in like manner, and to be by her
from time to time, affixed and administered by her
the County of Richmond who are unwilling to be
unable to give them education - and my Executor to
to the Court of Ordinary until the same be
provided,
I do hereby devise and bequeath unto Elizabeth (the wife of
who now lives with me) and to her Executors administration
of my estate, I do hereby devise and bequeath unto my
deceased & her daughter Phyllis, with whom I do hereby devise and bequeath
the same are not to be devised to her husband, Elizabeth & Phyllis
the life of my beloved wife, and to be by her
with approbation, provided always and it is my express desire
that the devise to the said Elizabeth & Phyllis shall be void and of no effect
in case she should be taken away or leave my wife and live contrary
contrary to my wife's desire, and also to be void and of no effect
during the life time of my wife, even when she should be taken away
my wife's consent or approbation, and in the property of my
my Estate by the happening of either of the contingencies above mentioned.
It is my will and in that case I do hereby devise to my daughter
Margery wife of Mr. Richard Beall, her Executors administration
and assigns; and I do hereby in that case, devise to her and Phyllis
their future issue and increase unto my wife, from Beall, and to
her, executors administrators and assigns forever.
I do hereby devise and bequeath unto my beloved wife, from Beall
and to her heirs and assigns forever, all that lot or parcel of land
in the City of Augusta, known by the No. 5, adjoining all Benj. H. H.
and bounded by the Bay & by Reynolds and Elliot streets with the
improvements thereon; also all my plate and household and kitchen
furniture, beds, bedding and table linen and all my stock of horses
hogs and sheep, except my Cattle in Montgomery County, which I do hereby
will; I also give her all my plantation tools & utensils, my
books and instruments of husbandry with the same, and I do hereby
with full provisions, given and provided of all the same
of the house or plantation of the said my daughter
that may then be growing, and to be by her
and assigns forever.
