

In the name of God Amen, I Thomas Booker of the County of Prince Edward being apprehensive of death, near & at hand and final change, anxious to secure the peace and happiness of my friends when I am gone, do herein this my last Will and Testament after reciting rendering my soul to the mercy and grace of that God who gave it, I desire my Estate to be divided in the following manner.

Item primus, I give and devise to my beloved brother Gideon and William F. Booker three hundred and fifty seven acres of land in Prince Edward County Virginia, part of a tract of five hundred and seven acres willed me by my Father, to be equally divided between them & their & each of their Heirs forever, and the remaining one hundred and fifty acres I gave and devised to my brother John Booker to him and his Heirs forever, to be laid off adjoining the Western line of my said brother Johns land, run by George Walker. I give and devise to my brothers Gideon & William F. Hounoy & to my sister Mary Williams Booker two negroes Bill and Charaby, to be equally divided between them and their and ~~and~~ ^{the} Heirs forever. I give and divide to my brother William Hounoy a tract of land granted me by the state of Georgia containing five hundred and seventy five acres, also my part of the land lying on the road leading from Prince Edward Court house to Little Run Oak Bridge in the said County of Prince Edward Virginia to him and his Heirs forever. It is my desire that

not also be paid out of the Legacies of my
sons George and William T. Booker, without
making any adjustment, lastly, I do hereby appoint
my brothers George Booker and William T. Booker
Co-executors to this my last Will and Testament.
