Richmond being apprehensive of drawing near to my final
and final change, desirous to secure the peace and happiness
of my friends when I am gone, do herein this my last Will
and Testament after recommending my soul to the
Mercy and grace of that God who gave it, I devise
my Estate to be divided in the following manner
I do hereby give and devise to my beloved brother, Gideon
and William F. Booker three hundred and fifty seven
acres of land in Prince Edward County Virginia,
part of a tract of five hundred and seven acres with
me by my Father, to be equally divided between them
& their & each of their heirs forever and the remaining
one hundred and fifty acres I give and devise
to my brother John Booker to him and his heirs
forever, to be laid off adjoining the Western line
of my said brother John's land, run by George Walton
I give and devise to my brothers Gideon & William
Flournoy & to my sister Mary Williams Booker
two negroes Will and Charaty to be equally divided
between them and their and each of their heirs forever
I give and devise to my brother William Flournoy
a tract of land granted me by the State of Georgia
containing five hundred and seventy five acres,
also my part of the land lying on the Road leading
from Prince Edward Court House to Little Town Oak
Bridge in the said County of Prince Edward Virginia
to him and his heirs forever, It is my desire that

and do hereby bequeath out of the Legacies of left my
brothers Gideon and William T. Booker, without
making any apportionment, lastly I do hereby appoint
my brothers Gideon Booker and William T. Booker
Executors to this my last Will and Testament
