be my last Will and Testament first of all I
commit my soul into the hands of my merciful
Creator hoping for salvation through the merits of my
saviour Jesus Christ and my body to its mother
earth to be buried in a Christian like manner
at the discretion of my wife Lucy Bugg my
brother Sherwood Bugg and my brother in law Peter
Paris & my uncle William Hobson whom I appoint
my Executors and Coexecutors into this my last Will
and Testament and then as to my worldly Estate
I give and dispose of them as followeth Viz.
Item I give and bequeath to my son John Bugg
a Negro Girl named Let also a Negro lad named
Sam to him and his heirs lawfully begotten
of his body forever
Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth
Bugg a Negro girl named Han also all the increase
the increase of a Negro wench named Sarah the
mother of Han to her and her heirs lawfully
begotten of her body forever also a Negro man
named Jeday

I give and bequeath to my Wife Lucy
Bugg a negro woman named Sarah the
mother of Hen during life of my beloved wife
life also a Negro man named Jorday during
her widowhood and also all the rest of them
and then at the day or time of Marriage then
to remain still in her possession it that my
Executors think my Children done a good part by
who ever may come into the family as they will
be a Judge of that matter and for my Children
to be well schooled and well brought up in
Christian like manners for my Estate to Educate
and to raise my Children and if they refuse
so to do for it to be immediately taken out
of their hands and also my Children and
for them to be raised and brought up on
their Estates

And it is my Will desire that my Wife is to
have a House to the value of any good riding
House that is fit for a woman and furniture
also the House and furniture also and Equal
part of the Cattle that is now belonging to
the Estate for the Cattle to be divided between
my Wife my son John Bugg and Elizabeth
Bugg my daughter and it is my Will and
desire that all my Houses to be sold and
a thousand

a thousand pounds of the money to purchase
a piece of land for my family it was one of the
Cremator or Cremators shall think fit and it is my
Will and desire that the plantation to belong to my
son John Buzz and also it is my Will and desire
that the money that may be raised by the sale of
my houses to be equally divided between my son
John Buzz and my Daughter Elizabeth Buzz
after a thousand pounds taken out of it as I
mentioned before to buy a plantation and it is
my Will and desire that my Daughter Elizabeth
Buzz have a feather bed and furniture it is my
Will that if either of my Children dies without
an heir that their Estate go to the other and if
both of them dieing and leaving no heirs then be
equally divided between my Wife and my Sisters
Brothers.

Now It is my Will and desire that all my just debts
be paid and I hereby revoke all other Will heretofore
made by me Witness hands and seal this 12 day
of ~~March~~ in the year of our Lord One thousand
seven hundred and eighty
