Know all Men that I, Thomas Connell, in the event of any accident
happening me during my passage to America, I
hereby appoint you my Executor I therefore Surrender
you my Contract of Copartnership with Mr. Henry
Donald, the House is Rent on the Company Account
the Rent my own property & it is recorded in Richmon
d County, And in the event of my Death I hereby
nominate & appoint you sole Executor Attorney or
Administrator you will please remit my Effects to
~~my Brothers~~ James & John Connell of Glasgow my pro
perty to be equally divided among them & the rest of
my Brothers & Sisters with One Hundred Guinea as a
present to my Mother I have sealed up the Inclosed
Contract it need only be opened in the event of my
Death Wishing you all happiness I am Dr Sir
