I give unto Brother Charles my Saddle & Bridle & all my
other wearing apparel & fifthly I will that my land
in South Carolina be Equally Divided amongst my four
Sisters Sixthly I will & bequeath unto my Mother Frances
Crawford my Horse & all my debts dues & demands after
my Lawful debts are paid Seventhly I will & bequeath
my Gun to my Brother Robert Crawford Lastly I do
appoint & constitute my Brother Joel Crawford
my Executor to this my last will & Testament For
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal
This 11th Day of November 1789.
