I will that my funeral expenses shall first be paid in the order of my temporal affairs and then will and desire that all my just debts be paid and of the balance of my property I give and bequeath to my son Daniel Henry the sum of One thousand Dollars, as a special gift to be held in Trust for him by my Executor hereafter named with full power and condition that if he dies before he arrives at the age of twenty one years then to revert and to be divided share & share equally between my Wife and my other Children, The Rest & Remainder of my Property I give and bequeath share & share alike to be divided equally between my Wife and my Children. my dear Wife & Children I do hereby appoint to have specially in charge as regards their temporal affairs. I hereby nominate and appoint my affectionate Brother Daniel Henry as my sole Executor hereby revoking & annulling all former Wills & Testaments made by me, signed and sealed by me this 1st day of March 1864.
