frying-pan to be equally divided amongst my
Children Jane Dikes George Dikes Unity Dikes
Love Dikes & Mary Dikes I also give and bequeath
to my Daughter Unity Dikes a feather bed and
furniture and Cow and Calf I also give and
bequeath to my Daughter Mary Dikes a feather
bed and furniture and a Cow and Calf.

I also give and bequeath to my Daughter
Rebecca Dikes a feather bed and furniture.
I also give and bequeath to my Daughter
Martha Dikes a feather bed and furniture.
I also give and bequeath to my son Levi Dikes
my horse bated and a bridle and saddle.
I also give and bequeath to my son Noah Dikes
my mare called Sal and a saddle a bridle

I also give and bequeath to my four sons
Jesse Dikes George Dikes Levi Dikes and Noah
Dikes my shoe maker tools and Cooper tools
and wheel rights tools to be equally divided
amongst them. I also give my Daughters
Susannah Granberry and Esther Tyson five
shillings a piece sterling money.

I also appoint Jesse Dikes and George Dikes
the Executors of this my last Will and Testament
and I declare this only to be my last will and
Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and Seal this nineteenth day of
April One thousand seven hundred and ninety
signed sealed and delivered
