I give and bequeath to My Executor hereafter named, in trust for My Daughter, Mary Anna, formerly the wife of Christopher Smith Deceased and now I understand the wife of a W. Stogall all the rest and residue of My Estate real & Personal after the payment of My debts, for the support of herself and any lawful Issue she may have, during her life & at her death to any Child or Children she may leave, but should she be leaving no child then I give and bequeath ~~the same to my said~~ Executor in trust for the Children of My nephew John Sanges allowing My said Nephew to receive the income of My said Estate during his life for the support of himself and his Children.

It is my will that my said Executor should be think it prudent to do so, but not otherwise, deliver over my said estate or any part of it, to My said Daughter Mary Anna, to be used by her, for her own support and for the support of her Children if she has any, or to my said Nephew John Sanges, in the event of his Children becoming, entitled to it under this will, for his own and their support during his life as aforesaid. I request My Executors to Wall up My Grave, and put a plain Slab over My Grave

It is My will that My said Executor in the Management of My Estate, use his own discretion in buying or selling property in any way which he may conceive will be of Benefit to it.

I hereby Nominate Constitute and appoint John H. Mann, Executor of this My last Will and Testament.
