In the name of God: Amen:

I Elizabeth Willson Alias Betsey Keating Considering the
uncertainty of this mortal life and being of sound Mind
and Memory Do Make and publish This My last Will
and Testament, in manner and form following that
is to Say:-

First.

I give and bequeath unto my two Daughters and
my two Sons, Emily Willson, Elizabeth Hinton, Joseph
Willson and John Willson Ten Shares each of Stock of
the Bank of Augusta in the State of Georgia, which I
hold in my own name and individual right which said
Several Legacies or bequest I Will and order to be paid
to the said respective Legates, within Six Months after
my Decease:-

I give and bequeath to my son Joseph Willson
In Trust for my Son Henry Edward Hart, One Bond
or Certificate of the Alabama Life Insurance and Trust
Company of One Thousand Dollars, bearing interest at
the rate of Six per. Cent pr. annum:-

I give and bequeath to my son Joseph Willson
In Trust for my Grandson Joseph Greenfield McClendon
one Bond or Certificate of the Alabama Life Insurance
and Trust Company aforesaid of Five Hundred Dollars
bearing interest as aforesaid: the said Interest to be
Devoted to the use and support of the said Legates
respectively during their Minority and the said Bonds
or principle Sums to be paid to them respectively
as they shall become of the age of Twenty One Years.

I further give and bequeath to my Daughters
Emily Willson, and my two sons Joseph Willson and
John Willson Their Heirs and assigns all my right,
Title and Interest in and to the messuage or tenement

First.

I give and bequeath unto my two Daughters and my two Sons, Emily Willson, Elizabeth Willson, John Willson and John Willson Sen shared each of Stock of the Bank of Augusta in the state of Georgia, which I hold in my own name and individual right which I leave to several Legacies or bequests. I will and order to be paid to the said respective Legates, within six months after my Decedat.

Item

I give and bequeath to my son Joseph Willson In Trust for my Son Henry Edward Hart, one Bond or Certificate of the Alabama Life Insurance and Trust Company of One Thousand Dollars, bearing interest at the rate of Six per Cent per Annum.

Item

I give and bequeath to my son Joseph Willson In Trust for my Grandson Joseph Greenfield McCloud one Bond or Certificate of the Alabama Life Insurance and Trust Company aforesaid of Five Hundred Dollars bearing interest as aforesaid: the said Interest to be Devoted to the use and support of the said Legates respectively during their Minority and the said Bonds or principle sums to be paid to them respectively as they shall become of the age of Twenty One Years.

I further give and bequeath to my Daughter Emily Willson, and my two sons Joseph Willson and John Willson their Heirs and assigns all my Right, Title and Interest in and to the messuage or tenement (in and upon which we now together reside) Situate Lying and being on the South side of Morgan Street No. 10 in the City of Philadelphia and County aforesaid together with all my free hold Estate Whatever, To Hold to them the said Emily Willson, Joseph Willson and John Willson, Share and Share alike being one equal third part to each, their Heirs and assigns forever and Lastly, as to all the Rest and Residue and Remains of my personal Estate goods and Chattels of what Kind and Nature Soever, I give and bequeath the same to

Daughter Emily Willson and My Two Sons Joseph
Willson and John Willson share and share alike
And I hereby appoint my Daughter Emily Willson
and My son Joseph Willson. Sole Executors of this
My last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former
Wills by me made.
