sition mind and memory make and declare my last will and
testament as follows

1st To my son-in-law Geo. Lee I give a black boy a slave woman
Bony a small bedroom and a bed and Mattress bedstead
and bedding complete and care to him and his heirs forever

2^d I direct that all the rest of my Estate real and personal
be sold by my Executor and the proceeds equally divided be-
tween my brothers and sisters Hugh Leslie McCrady William McCrady
James McCrady Peggy McCrady Sally McCrady and Polly McCrady
share and share alike to them and their heirs forever after pay-
ment of debts & funeral expenses Lastly I nominate and appoint Geo

Lee my Executor revoking all former wills I write and
I direct set my hand and seal this 19th day of September 1839

Codicil to the last will and Testament of Elizabeth McCrady
On my last will and Testament made yesterday I omitted to
make mention of any interest in the Estate of my father
William McCrady late of Anderson District South Carolina
in which I am disposed of as follows I give one half
thereof to my son in law Geo. Lee and his heirs forever
the other half I give to my brothers and sisters as follows

given the residue of my estate to my wife, I have
to William McBrady, Hugh Leslie McBrady, James
McBrady, Sarah McBrady, Peggy Estlin called in my will
Peggy McBrady, and Sally Kersey called in my will
Sally McBrady which legates here named are the
persons to whom I give the residue of my estate
as well as the half of my interest in my father's estate
above mentioned. In witness whereof I have hereunto
my hand and seal this 20th Sept 1839
