and the said Robert Jones granted to William Shubert, all
the said structures granted to Robert Jones, Also one hundred acres
of land situate, Also two hundred acres granted to Henry Jones
of the County aforesaid, To wit, to a County full and well settled, the

loved but of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make, order
and establish this my last Will and Testament, that is to say,
I give and bequeath my negro Woman Molly and her Child Argemone
together with her and their issue and increase to my Daughter Anna
Jones nee Amelia Ware, but in case my said Daughter Anna should
without lawful issue, then and in that case, that the said Molly and
increase shall become the Property of my two sons Smith Jones and
Robert Jones to be equally divided between them share & share alike,
And the residue and rest of my property both Real and Personal I give
and bequeath to my two sons Smith Jones and Robert Jones and my Daughter
Margaret Jones new married Pastell to be equally divided between them
share and share alike to them and their heirs forever, But my will
is and I desire that in the event my said Daughter Margaret Pastell should
without lawful issue then and in that event, the Property will
be divided to my two sons and become the Property of my two sons
Smith Jones and Robert Jones to be divided equally between them share and share alike
to them and their heirs forever. And I hereby nominate constitute
and appoint my two sons and my Daughter Margaret Pastell Executors
of this my last Will and Testament, writing my hand and seal this 20th day
