present owned by me, with all the improvements
made into a manufacturing - also all my Household
Furniture & Goods in the Village of Campbellton
aforesaid together with all Bonds, Notes and
Accounts due to myself alone, and the half of the same
Notes and Accounts on the books of and due to the
Parish after all my just debts are paid.

Item - I give and bequeath to my friend John A. the
my Saddle and Bridle, together with my Whetstone.

Item - I give and bequeath to my friend Charles
Martin Sen^r all the wearing Apparel & Linen
possessed of at the time of my Death.
