being upon Greene and Telfair Streets of Said City, also
all my real Estate situated lying and being in the Village
of Summerville in the County of Richmond and State
aforesaid also Twenty Shares of the Capitol Stock of
The Augusta Insurance and Banking Company now
standing in my Name upon the Books thereof and
also two Negro Slaves to Wit Elzy and Susan to have and
to hold the aforesaid property both real and personal
for ever. To be held in trust nevertheless by the said
Samuel Clarke and Robert or the Survivor of them for
the sole use and benefit of my Daughter Adeline C.
Clarke during her life - and after her Death all
my aforesaid property, both real and personal is to
be held in Trust by my aforesaid Trustees or the
Survivor of them for the sole use and benefit of my Grandchildren
the issue of my Said Daughter. and the said Samuel
Clarke, in which it is my Will, that my Said
Grandchildren share and share alike and receive their
distributive Share of my aforesaid property as each but
of lawful age if deemed expedient by my said Executrix
or the Survivor of them so to do. And it is my Will
that if my said Executors or the Survivor of them
deem it necessary I give them or him full power to
sell the property both real

of those Trustees of this My last Will and Testament and direct that all My debts be paid by said Executors as soon as practicable after My death and bequeath to the Daniel & Samuel Clarke Robert Clarke all My real Estate situated upon being upon Greene and Tiffair Streets of Said City all My real Estate situated lying and being in the County of Hanover and of Summersville in the County of Richmonde and offoresaid also Twenty Shares of the Capitol Stock of the Augusta Insurance and Banking Company Now standing in My Name upon the Books thereof and also two Negro Slaves to Wit Elroy and Susan to have and to hold the aforesaid property both real and personal forever. To be held in trust Mowethatby the said Daniel Clarke and Robert or the Survivor of them the sole use and benefit of My Daughter Adeline Clarke during her life - and after her Death my aforesaid property both real and personal to be held in Trust by My aforesaid Trustees or the Survivor of them for the sole use and benefit of My Grandchildren the issue of My said Daughter and the said Daniel Clarke, in which it is My Will, that My said Grandchildren Share and Share alike and receive Distributive Share of My aforesaid property at each his lawful age if deemed expedient by My said Executors or the Survivor of them so to do. And it is My Will that if My said Executors or the Survivor of them need it necessary I give them or him full power with provider of see My aforesaid property both real and personal to the Maintenance and Education of My Grandchildren as well as to the Maintenance and Support of My said Daughter.

I give and bequeath to My said Executors a sum of One and one half Shares and their Share of the Capital Stock to be now standing in My Name

same for ever. To be held in Trust nevertheless by My Said
Executors or the Survivor of them for the equal use and benefit of all
My Grandchildren to wit John Clarke Frances Moore Clarke
Thomas Mc Clarke Robert Campbell Clarke Mary Bonis Clarke
Eleanor Jane Clarke as well as all other issue of my Said
Daughter and the Said Samuel Clarke to share and share
alike, in the same, and to receive their distributive Shares
thereof in the following Manner to wit that of Grandsons
to be given them as they become of lawful age if deemed
expedient by My Said Executors or the Survivor of them -
That of my Granddaughters to be held in trust as
aforesaid for their use and that of their issue and in case
of the Death of any of My Said Grandsons or that of any of
them before he or they arrive at lawful age then and in that
case or cases his portion or their portions is to be divided
Equally between the survivors of my aforesaid Grandchildren
and in case of the Death of any of my Said Granddaughters
without issue, then and in that case her or their portions
or portions is to be held in trust as aforesaid for the use

kind of which I may die possessed. to have and to hold the
Same for Ever. To be held in Trust nevertheless by my Said
Executors or the Survivor of them for the equal use and benefit of all
my Grandchildren to wit John Clarke Frances Moore Clarke
Thomas M. Clarke Robert Campbell Clarke Mary Bones Clarke
Eleanor Jane Clarke as well as all other issue of my Said
Daughter and the Said Samuel Clarke to share and have
alike, in the same, and to receive their Distributive Shares
thereof in the following Manner to wit that of Grandsons
to be given them as they become of lawful age if deemed
expedient by my Said Executors or the Survivor of them -
That of my Granddaughters to be held in trust as
aforesaid for their use and that of their issue and in case
of the Death of any of my Said grandsons or that of any of
them before he or they arrive at lawful age then and in that
Case or Cases his portion or their portions is to be divided
Equally between the survivor of my aforesaid Grandchildren
and in case of the Death of any of my Said Granddaughters
without issue, then and in that Case her or their portion
or portions is to be held in trust as aforesaid for the use
and Benefit of the Survivor or Survivors of my Said Granddaughter
and her or their issue. And Lastly it is my will that if deemed
