this my last will & Testament revoking and annulling
all other heretofore made and first of all I commend my
soul to Almighty God and my body to the earth to be decent-
ly buried as my Executors hereafter mentioned and as my word
by Gods which pleased God to be shew to me, I dispose as followeth (to wit)
I Give & bequeath to my two Grand Daughters Luscindy and
Morning Harris my part of a Negro woman named Lory and
her Increase to be Equally divided between them and their heirs
forever ~~and further~~ I Give Luscindy one heifer and all her shee
increase to her & hers forever, but he increase I give to Richard
Dunn & his heirs - Item, I Give Morning Harris one Cow & all
her shee increase to her & her heirs forever but the shee increase
I give to Richard Dunn & his heirs - Item I Give Luscindy
Harris one Featherbed & furniture to her and her heirs forever
I likewise Give Luscindy one Leather trunk - I do appoint
my friend Waters Dunn and Richard Dunn my Executors to
this my will as witness my hand and seal this 28 day of Decem-
uary Anno Domini 1786 -
