and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to Die do
make and Ordain this my last will and Testament. That is to say
Unceasingly and first of all I Give and Recommend my soul to
the hand of Almighty God that gave it, and my body
I recommend to the Earth, to be Buried in Decent Christian
burial at the Discretion of my Executors nothing Doubting
but at the General Resurrection, I shall Receive the same again
by the Mighty Power of God, and as Touching my worldly Estate
where with it hath pleased God to bless me in this Life, I Give Do
give and Dispose of the same in the following manner & form -
First I Give and bequeath to my son George Harris the sum of five
Shillings Sterling and his heirs for ever - - - - -
Second I Give and bequeath unto my sons namely Benjamin
Zephaniah Echill and James, the sum of Twenty Shillings Sterling
to them their heirs and assigns for ever - - - - -
I Give and bequeath to my Daughters Sarah & Belinda fifty
Acres of Land each to be taken out of a Tract of two hundred
and fifty Acres of Land in Burke County known by
my Upper Tract and to be taken out of the upper end of
said Tract upon Simon's Branch Together with all
Appurtenances thereunto belonging to them their heirs
and assigns for ever - - - - -
I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Rachel the sum
of five Shillings Sterling to her heirs and assigns for ever -

Reverend of my friends and family
together with all my friends your witnesses
and I hereby nominate constitute and appoint
and Behold my wife Sarah Harris Sole Executor of this
Will and Testament and I hereby utterly Revoke
and Disallow all and every other former Testament Will of
Devises and Bequests by me in any ways before made
and bequeathed ~~and~~ and Confirming this and
no other to be my Last Will and Testament. In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the sixth
Day of November One thousand seven hundred and
Eighty five.
