of the same as follows, viz. for the land I bear towards my particular friend
James Pace of the City of Augusta State & County aforesaid I do give and
bequeath unto him all my estate both real and personal to wit one tract of
land situated in the State of Indiana about seven miles from the River
Ohio the same was purchased by me at the Government sale during the
administration of John Quincy Adams the titles of which I left in the care
of Mr. Murk of the City of Albany in the State of Indiana whom he writ-
ten to very recently to send the said titles to me by mail. And also I do
give and bequeath unto the said James a Lot of land in the City of
Charleston South Carolina the improvements thereof may have been burnt
by the late fire in Charleston. In witness whereof I've hereunto set my hand
and seal this 16 day of August A.D. Eighteen hundred and thirty eight
