

Georgia. In the name of God Amen I the said
Robertson make in body but of sound mind and memory first
God be blest, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament
in manner following.

First. It is my will and desire that all my just debts be paid.
Secondly. It is my will and desire that my tract of land on Swan
Creek in Burke County containing seven hundred and fifty acres
be reserved for the use & benefit of my four Children viz. Polly
Tabitha Nathan Zephaniah and Adeline, until my said daughter
Adeline marries or comes of age, but in the event of the marriage
of either of my said Children anterior to the marriage or coming of age
of my said daughter Adeline, then and in that case the enjoyment
of the use of said land by the one so marrying to cease & at the
marriage or coming of age of my daughter Adeline the afore said land
to be equally divided between my four daughters viz. Polly, Rebekah
Tabitha and Adeline. It is also my will and desire that my household
& kitchen furniture Carriage and Carriage boxes be reserved for the
use of the Children now with me.

Thirdly. It is my will and desire and I therefore give and
bequeath to my two sons Nathan and Zephaniah the high land
tract of land wherein I now live and also six hundred acres on
Savannah River beginning at my upper line of said river and running
back so as to include the brick patch field and a tract I purchased of
Charles Ward thence round my line and to the river so as to make
the quantity of six hundred acres, and in the event of one of my sons
dying under age that the other shall inherit his part of said land.

Fourthly. I give and bequeath all the residue of my land on
Savannah River to my four daughters viz. Polly, Rebekah, Tabitha
and Adeline.

Fifthly. I give and bequeath to my daughter Rebekah Pastwick
four Negroes viz. Mule and his Wife Betty and three pair of fat stock
also two Negroes called Patience and Cesar all of which said daughter
is now in possession of.

Sixthly. I lend to my daughter Eleanor Harris for the term of her
natural life five Negroes viz. Peter, Peggy, Spencer, Susan and
Cumberland and at her death to be possessed for ever by the heirs
of her body should she leave any. If not for said Negroes to be
