Honor Cox of the County of Richmond and State aforesaid, of weak
body health, and in expectation of mortal dissolution, but of sound mind
and disposing memory, calling to mind the uncertainty of human events,
being desirous to settle my worldly affairs whilst I have mental capacity
do make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and
Testament, hereby revoking and making void all former wills by me, at any
time made.

And first of all I desire of my Executors herein after named, to have this body
buried in a plain decent christianlike manner.

As to my worldly Estate, I give, dispose of and bequeath it as follows viz,
I desire that my two daughters viz Delilah Branch who is the wife of Walter
Branch of the State of South Carolina, and Martha Dillon who is the wife
of William C. Dillon of the State of Georgia and residing in the City of
Augusta, should hold, possess and enjoy whatever property I shall be
possessed of, and to the end that the same shall, in no wise, be liable to or
subject to the debts, claims and incumbrances of their present or any future
husbands or husbands, in any manner or shape whatsoever. I do therefore bequeath
my friend Garaway to Sammar my Negro slave in number named as
follows viz. Sally, Mike (or Michael), Hester, Susan, Henry, Tom, Mary, Brown,
Mary Brown, Candice, Sarah and Sally to be held by her in trust, for the
benefit use and advantage of my children and daughters.

of the said my said husband or of their present husbands or any future
Husbands or husbands they may hereafter have. And I do also bequeath
to my said daughter all my household furniture of every description, and
also my stock and bays, and all the money due to me on account of them
to be held by him in the same manner as is expressed and declared of
and concerning the Negroes above mentioned. ~

It is my wish and desire that such of the aforesaid Negroes as may be
unwilling to belong to either of my said Daughters, be sold by my
Executors and the proceeds of sale to be placed in the hands of the
said Trustee herein named as aforesaid, and by him to be laid out for
other property, or divided between my said Daughters share and share alike,
subject however to the Trust herein created, and for the object and purposes
before expressed. ~

I desire that the few debts I owe, may be called in and paid and the property
divided, immediately after this my Will, is duly proved, by one or both of
my named Executors. - and that the same be placed in the hands and posses-
sion of my said Daughters, by equal shares or moieties, as is herein before
provided, without unnecessary delay. ~

Lastly, I do hereby nominate my son-in-law Lovelock Branch, and
my friend Edward Martin my Executors to carry into effect this my
last will. ~
